

“Scottsdale” 2010

This summer three kilometres of willow control will be carried out using a stem injection/foliar spraying technique on “Scottsdale” NSW. Three community planting days have occurred along Gungoandra Creek over the last year and Bush Heritage volunteers continue to undertake maintenance, weed and rabbit control and plantings along the creek and the Murrumbidgee River. In addition substantial erosion control works are being undertaken on the creek and associated gullies along with other reserve wide conservation activities.
